Sunday, April 16th – Easter Sunday, Resurrection of the Lord, Mass at **11:00 AM** in English, Mass at **5 PM** in Spanish

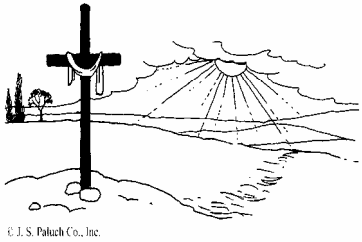
