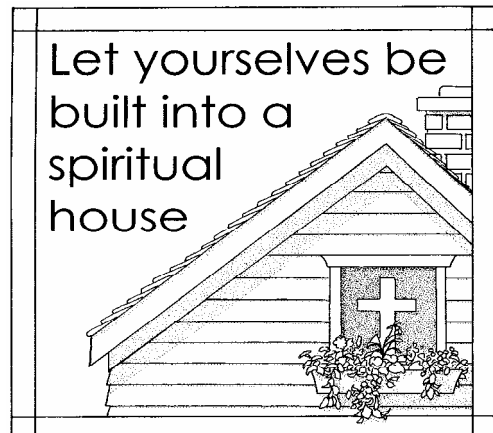

| -decide ahead of time what Mass to attend | -set out everyone's clothes so getting ready is not a hassle |
| -bring along a picture book about the Mass | -have something for everyone to put in the collection basket |
| -sit it front so children can see | -bring children through the communion line |
| -praise children for good behavior | -celebrate good behavior by doing something special after Mass |

(Behavior expected of everyone: when entering church all males should remove their hats, turn off cell phones, no loud talking, sit quietly in the seats during Mass; try not to disturb people that are praying.)
