This Sunday is The Feast of our Beloved Patron Saint Benignus. Son of the Druid Chieftan Sechnan, who was one of the very first converts of St. Patrick. He was very attached to Patrick as a boy, and later became Patrick's companion, confidant, and right hand man. He succeeded Patrick as the second Chief Bishop (Primate) of ALL IRELAND. He was renowned for his gentle disposition, his ardent evangelization of the rest of Ireland, and his important participation in the college of Bishops at the Council of Chalcedon.

He died in 467.

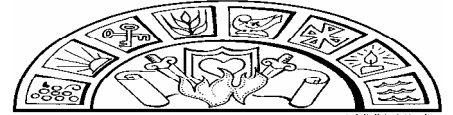

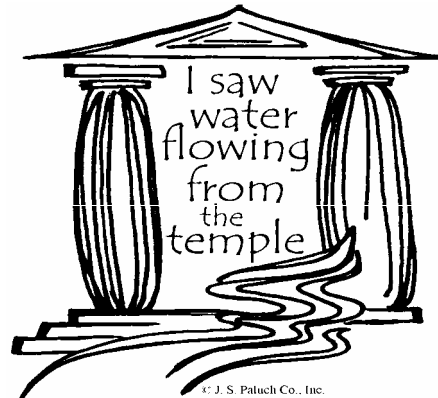
