NEWS AROUND THE PARISH

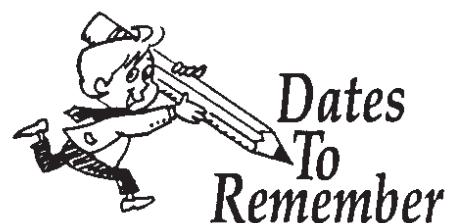
- The Knights of Columbus will be serving pancakes and bacon before Mass on Sunday, December 6. We will begin serving at 10:30 a.m. Please note new time.

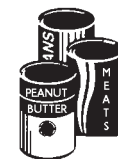
TODAY IN HISTORY
